

SSCHE2026 Conference Terms & Conditions

The 52nd International Conference of the Slovak Society of Chemical Engineering - SSCHE2026 will be held on 26-29 May 2026 at the hotel Sorea Trigan, Štrbské Pleso, High Tatras, Slovakia.

Conference fees (including meals) in euros for the SSCHE2026 conference are listed in the table below:

The conference fee includes:

- Participation in a social evening ('conference party')

- Administrative and organizational fees

Early = registration made before 28.2.2026

Standard = registration made 1.3.2026 - 15.4.2026

Late = registration made after 15.4.2026, but no later than 15.5.2026. After this date, you need to inform yourself about the possibilities by e-mail at sschi@sschi.sk or by phone on +421 259 325 250. It will be possible to register for the conference after 15 May 2026, in limited numbers, taking into account the capacity of the conference, or also on site - accommodation and meals (except for participation in the social evening on 27.5.2026) are provided by the participant himself/herself in this case.

Participants can book accommodation for themselves and accompanying persons directly at the Sorea Trigan conference hotel via the conference system <https://sscheconference.sk>. Single and double rooms are available, as well as a limited number of multi-bed rooms. Breakfast and local tax are included in the price of accommodation. (Any special requests regarding room selection, multi-bed room reservations, and invoice allocation among participants staying in the room, etc., should be addressed directly to the Conference Secretariat at sschi@sschi.sk or +421 259 325 250). It is also possible to arrange accommodation individually in nearby hotels.

Meals for the conference participants and accompanying persons are provided in the hotel Sorea Trigan, while the meals are part of the conference fee. Meals will be served buffet style on the following days: 2× lunch on 27.5.2026 and 28.5.2026, 2× dinner on 26.5.2026 and 28.5.2026, 1× dinner during the social evening on 27.5.2026.

The conference fee for the conference participant and accompanying person includes free admission to the social evening 'conference party' on 27.5.2026.

Payment of the registration fee and other conference fees is also possible on the spot, even for conference participants registered through the conference system. Either in cash or by bank transfer; transfer instructions will be available at the conference reception. If you intend to use this option, please notify us via the contact form in the conference system or by e-mail at sschi@sschi.sk when registering in the conference system, or no later than 5.5.2026.

Substitution of a participant for another

There is no charge for exchanging a conference participant. In the event of an extension of conference participation, the extension of accommodation and meals is subject to hotel availability and is not guaranteed by the Conference Secretariat. SSCHI will not charge any fee for extensions of attendance if notified in time.

Cancellation policy and force majeure

Cancellations can only be made by email to sschi@sschi.sk.

No cancellation fee will be charged for cancellations up to and including 26.3.2026.

For cancellations between 27.3.2026 and 30.4.2026, inclusive, the cancellation fee is 50 % of the invoice amount.

For cancellations after 30.4.2026, the cancellation fee is 100 % of the invoice amount.

In the event of circumstances beyond the control of the conference participant, SSCHI, and Hotel Trigan (so-called "force majeure," i.e., natural disasters, fire, floods, natural catastrophes, acts of war or the threat thereof, civil unrest posing a threat to safety, pandemics, epidemics, infections, and restrictions imposed by Slovak government authorities) that neither party could have foreseen or prevented and as a result of which it is not possible to provide conference services in full or in part, SSCHI shall not be liable for their non-provision and shall proceed in accordance with the following cancellation conditions:

If the conference is canceled and announced on the conference website by March 26, 2026, inclusive, a cancellation fee of 25 % of the invoiced amount will be charged.

If the conference is canceled and announced on the conference website between March 27, 2026, and April 30, 2026, inclusive, a cancellation fee of 50 % of the invoiced amount will be charged.

If the conference is canceled and announced on the conference website after April 30, 2026, a cancellation fee of 100 % of the invoiced amount will be charged.

The above cancellation conditions also apply to accompanying persons and also to companies/teams presenting in the form of promotional tables.

Other

The accompanying person cannot be an author or co-author of a conference lecture or poster and does not have access to the scientific or technical programme of the conference. Registration of more than one accompanying person must be consulted in advance with the conference committee via the contact form on the conference website, by e-mail at sschi@sschi.sk or by phone on +421 259 325 250.

Conference participants are required to wear a name badge when moving around the conference facilities, as well as when eating in hotel restaurant.
