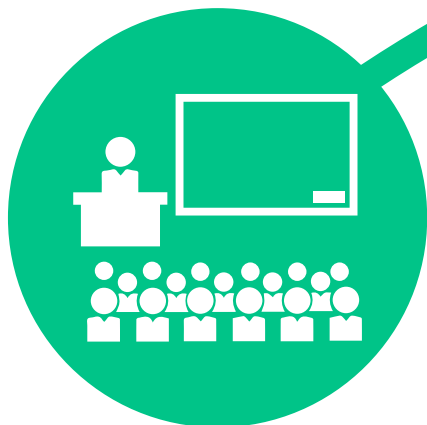
PRESENTATION FORM

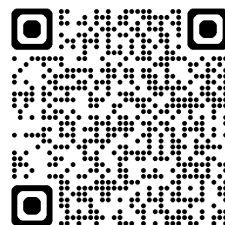
STUDENT POSTER AWARD
